He received his education in this town, graduating at the Punchard Free School In July, 1862. On the 15th of the following August he enlisted in Co. G of the 44th Massachusetts Volunteers, In which his elder brother had also already been enrolled. The following letter of his father, addressed to Captain Hunt, consenting to his enlistment, shows the spirit which inspired both father and son: Captain Hunt: My eldest son has enlisted in your company. I send you his younger brother. He is, and always has been, in perfect health, of more than the ordinary power of endurance, honest, truthful, and courageous. I doubt not you will find him on trial all you can ask, except his age, and that I am sorry to say is only sixteen; yet if our country needs his...
